How are we spending our time? Are we using our time to get closer to God? If we are wondering why our relationship with God isn't as strong as we'd like, maybe if we ask ourselves some

questions, a little self evaluation, we might be able to figure out how to spend our time better while getting closer to Him.

Here are a few I thought of:

- 1. How have you been spending your time? In the Bible we are told to set our mind on things above (Col. 3:2). Maybe we are spending too much time on the things of this world over things above.
- 2. Have you been studying the Bible? In the Bible we are told to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior (2 Peter 3:18). This is the way we understand Him more, by studying His inspired Word! When we know Him better, we have a stronger relationship.
- 3. Have you been praying? Communication is key. We are told to pray without ceasing (1 Thess. 5:17). Prayer should be a constant part of our life with God.
- 4. Have you been focusing on positive things? In Eph. 5:20 we are told to give thanks for all things. Being able to find positives even in negative situations is a clear sign of a good relationship with God!
- 5. Have you been seeking Godly things? We are told to seek God and His ways first (Matt. 6:33). Sometimes we are seeking things of this world over Godly things. If we are seeking Godly things daily then the other 4 questions are easily answered/dealt with properly.

So if we want to get closer to God do some self evaluation on how you are spending your time in relation to God. How are you spending your time? In Him. Todd
