Here are four lessons that we can quickly take away from these words of wisdom.

Enjoy the reward of children (v. 3-5)

Sometimes screaming babies, inquisitive toddlers, needy young ones, and temperamental teenagers can cloud our eyes to the blessings of our children. Don't forget to stop and enjoy the joy that they are now and will continue to be in the future.
